

Qualified Small Business Stock (QSBS) exclusion is a U.S. tax benefit that allows holders to potentially pay zero federal capital gains tax on up to \$10 million or 10 times their investment when selling shares, making it a valuable tax-saving opportunity. However, many eligible individuals are not taking advantage of this benefit. To address this, Carta's QSBS Attestation Letter simplifies the process of confirming QSBS eligibility and obtaining the necessary tax documentation.
